#### **EVENT FORMAT Categories:** WP, MP, MxP, WG, MG Levels: USDP Level 7-10 Youth FIG 11-16 (AG1), 12-18 (AG2), 13-19 (Junior), FIG Senior Level 7 1 Combined Routine to be performed 2 times. Ranking to be based upon the sum of the scores (C+C) **Level 8-10** 1 Balance Routine and 1 Dynamic Routine. Ranking to be based upon sum of the scores (B+D) Youth 1 Combined Routine to be performed 2 times. Ranking to be based upon sum of the two scores (C+C) FIG 11-16, 12-18, 13-19 1 Balance, 1 Dynamic and 1 Final. Ranking determined as per FIG rules. **PURPOSE** To provide a prestigious annual competitive opportunity at the national level for developing high performance gymnasts and showcase top provincial talent in the five categories of acrobatic gymnastics: Women's Pairs (WP), Men's Pairs (MP), Mixed Pairs (MxP), Women's Groups (WG) and Men's Groups (MG) To establish national rankings and declare Canadian Champions in: USDP Levels 7-10, Youth, FIG 11-16 (AG1), FIG 12-18 (AG2), FIG 13-19 (Junior) and FIG Senior To play a role in the selection process for major international events (FIG levels only): World Junior Challenge (Portugal Oct 27-29, 2023): Selection Event (TBC) Pan American Championships (Oct/Nov 2023): Routines performed at the Canadian Championships will be recorded and submitted for selection event as additional performances. These recordings will be judged by the selection panel together with videos submitted specifically for the selection event. The highest score achieved by the partnership for each of Balance Dynamic and Final will be used for selection purposes.

#### COACHES

The coaching certification requirements to attend GymCan national level competitions are as follows:

- NCCP Comp 1 (Introduction) Certified in Acrobatic Gymnastics
- NCCP Comp 2 (Introduction Advanced) Certified in Artistic Gymnastics (MAG or WAG); or
- Acrobatic gymnastics coaching certification from a FIG Academy or country recognized by Gymnastics Canada as a country with reputable coach education training

(please note: we will be phasing out NCCP Artistic qualifications as eligible for Acro); or

receive an exemption from the PM.

If coaches are NCCP Competition 1 (Introduction) Acro trained, no payment is required for the exemption request.

Provinces may send the above number of National ranked judges. If the allowable number of National judges is not available, provinces may send up to the allocated number of judges. Judges must have P3 equivalent experience and must meet the following criteria:

- 3 complete seasons of judging experience within the province
- Fully able to judge A and E at all levels of competition
- Familiar with Difficulty judging, tariff review, and fully versed in the use of the Tables of Difficulty

Approval of the nominees will be done by the Canadian Judge Chair.

Provinces/territories who are not allocated to send any judges but who have athletes participating in the Championships are encouraged to provide one (1) judge. This will ensure that the information that is being discussed at judge meetings and on panels can be brought back to aid the development of the athletes and judges in their own provinces/territories.

PTOs must register their judges on KSIS and complete the Judges Registration Form (link is available on KSIS) for Championships. The form is available on KSIS and was previously sent as an attachment. These forms must be returned by email to nlavoie@gymcan.org and ddsouza@cogeco.ca

All judges nominated to judge Championships must attend the National Judge Course, all the respective technical meetings, and must be available to judge all competition sessions.
